



# 1. THA TROPHY SELECTION CRITERIA

## 1.1 Selection Criteria for Individual Team Trophies

The following awards will be selected by the coach, manager, and in conjunction with the Regional Coaching Director for endorsement. Five (5) nominations to be considered with a winner and runner-up being selected.

Nominees to be selected on the following criteria

- a) Toowoomba Hockey Association ambassador and role model qualities;
- b) Demonstrated respect for Coach, Manager and peers;
- c) Team oriented rather than individual focus;
- d) Commitment and dedication demonstrated
- e) Skills demonstrated during championships.

Selection criteria for coaches and managers when nominating for awards are to be noted and submitted to justify their choices and provide this to Regional Coaching Director for his endorsement.

Rating/points as per below:

1= Very Good

2= Excellent

3= Exceptional

Awards under this category are:

- a) Under 13 Girl's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year (team 1 and 2);
- b) Under 13 Boy's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year (team 1 and 2);
- c) Under 15 Girl's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year (team 1 and 2);
- d) Under 15 Boy's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year;
- e) Under 18 Girl's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year;
- f) Under 18 Boy's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year;
- g) Chill Female Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year;
- h) Eagles Male Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year.

Super League players: Recognition by way of photo for each player that made Super League teams. No award for these players.

## 1.2 Selection Criteria for Individual Team Trophies (Masters)

Recognition of a sportsman and woman, in the master's category, who exhibits the highest level of skill, performance, attitude, behaviour and team spirit. This award to be selected by coach/coordinators of teams in conjunction with the Master's Portfolio on the Hockey Committee. Three (3) nominations with a winner being selected.

Awards under this category are:

- a) Women's Masters Representative Player of the Year (team 1 and 2);
- b) Men's Masters 35's – 45's Representative Player of the Year;
- c) Men's Masters 45+ Representative Player of the Year.



### **1.2.1 Highest Achieving Masters Player**

Recognition of a sportsman and woman, in the master's category, who has achieved the most in the masters division during the representative year. This award is to be selected by coach/coordinators of teams in conjunction with the Master's Portfolio on the Hockey Committee. Winner only, no nominations.

## **1.3 Selection Criteria for Perpetual Trophies**

### **1.3.1 THA Mick Paterson Volunteer of the Year Award**

This award is selected by the Board of Directors. Only awarded on merit as decided each year (doesn't have to be awarded). Merit to be determined by the Board of Directors. Winner only, no nominations.

### **1.3.2 Clubperson of the Year Award**

Club Presidents along with two (2) other clubs officials to nominate one (1) person within their club that has shown exceptional commitment, dedication and contribution to the club in any area throughout the year.

Nominations to be considered and a winner to be selected by the Chair of the Hockey Committee and President of the THA.

### **1.3.3 Umpire of the Year – Male and Female**

Recognition of female umpire, who has demonstrated an outstanding commitment to the Association in regards to umpiring throughout the year. Three (3) nominations with a winner being selected.

This award is selected by the Umpire Manager and Umpiring Portfolio on the Hockey Committee and a winner for the award based on the criteria specified above.

### **1.3.4 Academy Umpire of the Year**

Recognition of academy umpires, who have demonstrated improved ability throughout the year as well as an outstanding commitment to academy responsibilities. Winner only no nominations.

This award is selected by the Umpire Manager and Umpiring Portfolio on the Hockey Committee and a winner for the award based on the criteria specified above.

### **1.3.5 Association Umpire of the Year**

Clubs nominate two (2) unpanelled/non-academy umpires within their clubs to the THC for selection of a winner. By selected date.

### **1.3.6 Junior Representative Female Player of the Year**

Every junior female player (including under 18's) that is selected at a state level or higher throughout the year. Winner will be highest achieving junior representative selected by Regional Coaching Director, Chair Toowoomba Hockey Committee and Junior Chair of selectors. Winner only no nominations.

### **1.3.7 Junior Representative Male Player of the Year**

Every junior male player (including under 18's) that is selected at a state level or higher throughout the year. Winner will be highest achieving junior representative selected by Regional Coaching Director, Chair Toowoomba Hockey Committee and Junior Chair of selectors. Winner only no nominations.

### **1.3.8 Senior Representative Female Player of the Year**

Every senior female player (including under 18's) that is selected at a state level or higher throughout the year. Winner will be highest achieving junior representative selected by Regional Coaching Director, Chair Toowoomba Hockey Committee and Senior Chair of selectors. Winner only no nominations.

### **1.3.9 Senior Representative Male Player of the Year**

Every senior male player (including under 18's) that is selected at a state level or higher throughout the year. Winner will be highest achieving junior representative selected by Regional Coaching Director, Chair Toowoomba Hockey Committee and Senior Chair of selectors. Winner only no nominations.

### **1.3.10 Clive Berghofer Female Player of the Year**

1, 2, 3 votes allocated by panel umpires from A grades games.

### **1.3.11 Clive Berghofer Male Player of the Year**

1, 2, 3 votes allocated by panel umpires from A grades games.

### **1.3.12 Club Championship Award**

The club championship is awarded to the club who has accumulated the most points during the course of the season in all grades.

## 2. PROCEDURES

### 2.1 Individual Team Trophies

This applies to:

- a) Under 13 Girl's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year (Team 1 and 2);
- b) Under 13 Boy's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year (Team 1 and 2);
- c) Under 15 Girl's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year (Team 1 and 2);
- d) Under 15 Boy's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year;
- e) Under 18 Girl's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year;
- f) Under 18 Boy's Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year;
- g) Chill Female Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year;
- h) Eagles Male Toowoomba Representative Player of the Year;
- a) Women's Masters Representative Player of the Year (team 1 and 2);
- b) Men's Masters 35's – 45's Representative Player of the Year;
- c) Men's Masters 45+ Representative Player of the Year;
- d) Highest Achieving Masters Player.

Selection criteria to be included as part of the coach and manager reports to ensure that it is received in a timely manner before the end of the hockey season.

### 2.2 Selection Criteria for Perpetual Trophies

#### 2.2.1 THA Mick Paterson Volunteer of the Year Award

THC to liaise with the Board of Directors one (1) month prior to the THA End of Season Banquet requesting them to consider person to be win the award.

#### 2.2.2 Umpire of the Year

Umpiring Portfolio holder on the THC to liaise with Umpire Manager one (1) month prior to the THA End of Season Banquet.

#### 2.2.3 Academy Umpire of the Year

Umpiring Portfolio holder on the Hockey Committee to liaise with Umpire Manager one (1) month prior to the THA End of Season Banquet.

#### 2.2.4 Association Umpire of the Year

THC to request nominations from clubs of two (2) unpanelled/non-academy umpires one (1) month prior to the THA End of Season Banquet.

#### 2.2.5 Junior Representative Female Player of the Year

Toowoomba Hockey Committee to liaise with the Regional Coaching Director one (1) month prior to the THA End of Season Banquet requesting them to consider person to be win the award.

#### 2.2.6 Junior Representative Male Player of the Year

Toowoomba Hockey Committee to liaise with the Regional Coaching Director one (1) month prior to the THA End of Season Banquet requesting them to consider person to be win the award.

#### 2.2.7 Senior Representative Female Player of the Year

Toowoomba Hockey Committee to liaise with the Regional Coaching Director one (1) month prior to the THA End of Season Banquet requesting them to consider person to be win the award.

#### 2.2.8 Senior Representative Male Player of the Year

Toowoomba Hockey Committee to liaise with the Regional Coaching Director one (1) month prior to the THA End of Season Banquet requesting them to consider person to be win the award.

#### 2.2.9 Clive Berghofer Female Player of the Year

At the first THC meeting after the last A grade women's fixture round votes are to be counted and ratified.

#### 2.2.10 Clive Berghofer Male Player of the Year

At the first THC meeting after the last A grade women's fixture round votes are to be counted and ratified.

#### 2.2.11 Club Championship Award

After the last fixture rounds for the season the club championships table is to be finalised and presented at the next THC meeting to be ratified.
