



THA CASUAL REGISTRATION POLICY

1 Players

A Casual Player is a registered Senior or Masters player who plays no more than:

- a) Five (5) fixture games per season (Cas5); or
- b) Ten (10) fixture games per season (Cas10)

2 Registrations

Casual Registration is only available to Senior and Masters players.

Clubs must maintain a minimum of eleven (11) registered players who are not casual players, per team at all times.

Only members primary registering with THA may utilise Casual Registration.

Fully registered players cannot downgrade to Cas5 or Cas10.

3 Finals

No player shall take part in the semi-finals and finals unless having been registered and played at least six (6) fixture games in each of six (6) separate sets of fixture rounds for the relevant fixture section with their club during the season

NB: Cas5 players are not eligible for finals.

4 Fees

Cas5 registration includes:

- 100% Insurance Fees;
- 100% Hockey Australia Fees;
- 100% Hockey Queensland Fees;
- 100% Toowoomba Hockey Association Fees; and
- 30% Access Fees.

Cas10 registration includes:

- 100% Insurance Fees;
- 100% Hockey Australia Fees;
- 100% Hockey Queensland Fees;
- 100% Toowoomba Hockey Association Fees; and
- 60% Access Fees.

Casual Registration must be paid in full prior to any game being played, if it is not paid then the member is unregistered and the team will be subject to the penalty as outlined in Part 3.3 and 7.1 of the THA By Laws.

Should a member, who has purchased a Cas5 or Cas10 Registration, wish to play in further games that season then the member must pay a further fee (as outlined below) in full prior to playing any further games. Upon payment of the fee the member will be eligible to play the remainder of round games and finals in the season:

- Cas5 – 75% Access Fee
- Cas10 – 50% Access Fee

NB: The extra fee does not include insurance etc as this has been paid in the initial Cas5 or Cas10 registration.

The registration relates specifically to the number of games played and not the number of rounds. Therefore if the player utilising a casual registration runs onto the field for any amount of time to play it will be considered a game played. Further if a player plays in two games on the one day or similar then the player will have been considered to play two games or whatever number of games as the case may be.
