

JUDICIARY INITIAL ASSESSMENT INQUIRIES

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1. PURPOSE

1.1 Procedure to be followed to provide the THC with sufficient information to determine in a timely manner the appropriate process to resolve any alleged breach or misconduct.

3. PROCESS

- 3.1 Step 1: Hockey Manager provides all relevant material (copies) to the identified investigator in a timely manner. Material may include Match Report, Umpire Cards, complaint correspondence, video recordings and audio recordings. Player histories and contact details.
- **3.2** Step 2: Investigator will review material and liaise with the relevant players and possible witnesses to obtain versions. Versions may be oral or written and may be communicated by email.
- **3.3** Step 3: Investigator will review all material and provide a written report to the THC for consideration.

4. CLARIFICATIONS

- **4.1** Note 1: Players and witnesses are under no obligation to provide versions at this time.
- **4.2** Note 2: Players and witnesses are entitled to have a support person present during any interview.
- **4.3** Note 3: Players and witnesses under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardian present during any interview.
- **4.4** Note 4: All players and witnesses will be entitled to a copy of any interview or statement provided by them to the investigator.
